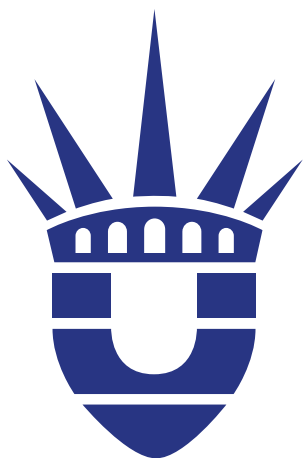

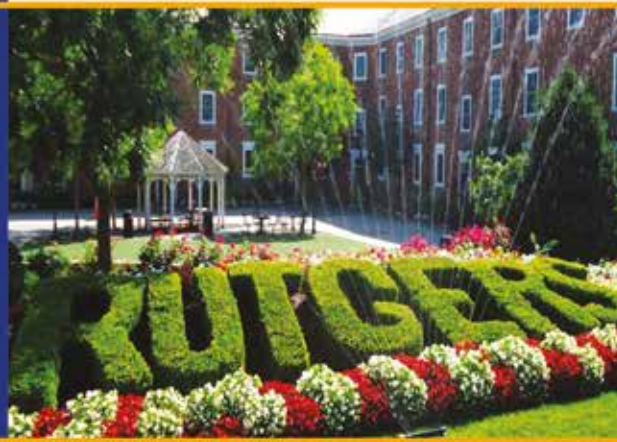

MBA curriculum equips students with business competencies in market demand, significantly improving career prospects of our students.

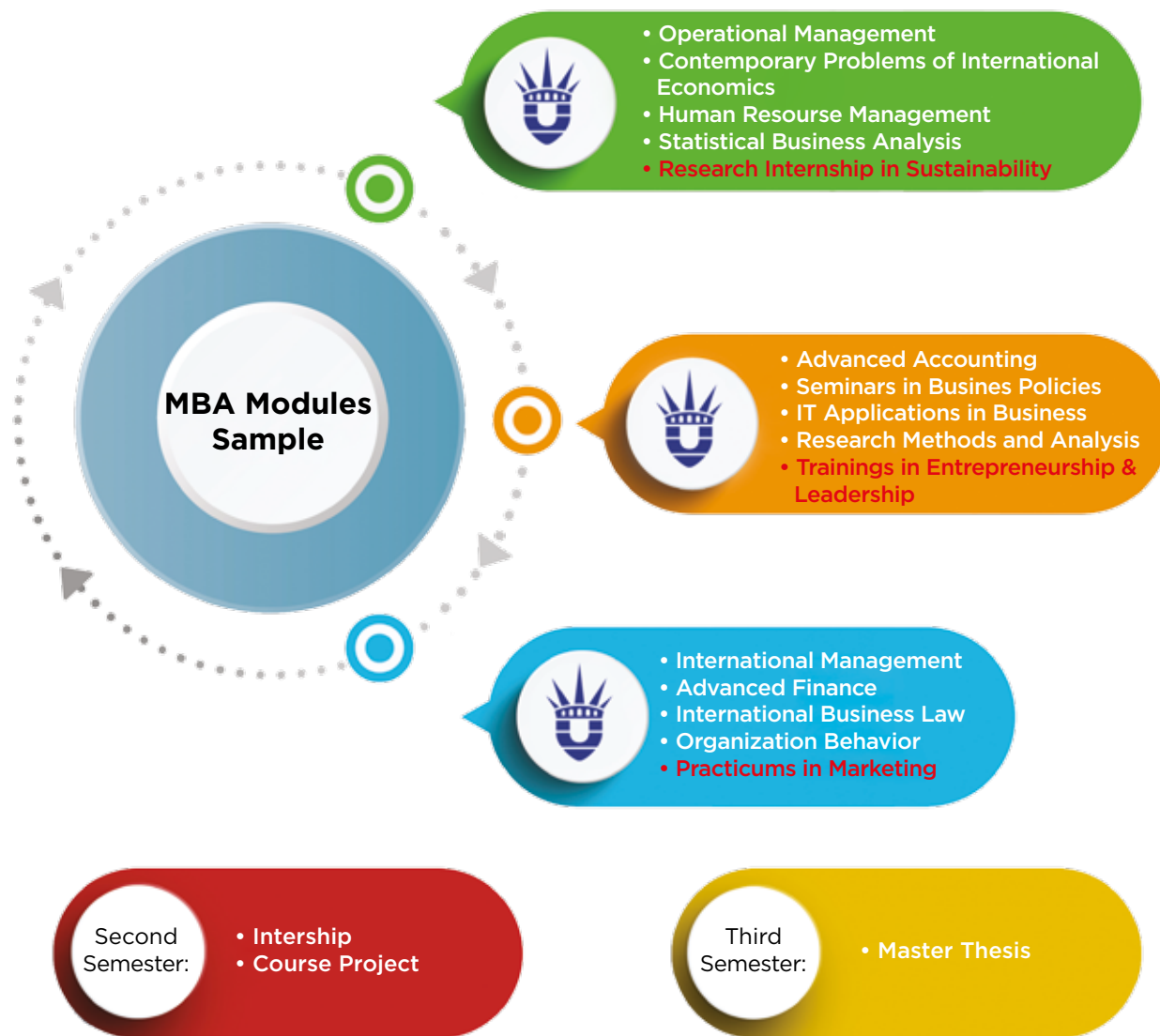
