

## *GPA calculation*

It is very important for students to know how the Grade Point Average (GPA) is calculated in order to build a strategy for working on the program.

GPA is calculated as follows. Depending on how many ECTS credits are awarded to each of the courses, the number of ECTS credits earned from each course is multiplied by a factor corresponding to the grade obtained (the coefficient can be found in the table below).

<b>Average</b>	0-34	35-59	60-69	70-74	75-82	83-89	90-100
<b>Ltr Grade</b>	F	FX	E	D	C	B	A
<b>GPA (Bachelor Students)</b>	0,00	0,00	0,25	1,00	2,00	3,00	4,00
<b>GPA (Master Students)</b>	0,00	0,00	0,00	1,00	2,00	3,00	4,00

The obtained values for all courses are summarized and divided by the number of ECTS credits assigned for these courses. The following example illustrates how to calculate the GPA (for Bachelor Students):

<b>Course</b>	<b>ECTS Credits</b>	<b>Letter Grade</b>	<b>Mark</b>	<b>Points</b>
Business Law	6	A	95	6x4=24
IT Applications	6	B	88	6x3=18
Organizational Behavior	6	A	92	6x4=24
International Economic Relations	6	C	80	6x2=12
<b>Total</b>	<b>24</b>			<b>78</b>

This student's GPA would be 3.25 (78 points divided by 24 credits attempted).
