Requirements for abstracts:

The volume should not exceed 2 pages.

Materials must be prepared using the MS Word editor. Paper format A4. Headset Times New Roman, size 14, spacing 1. All margins - 25 mm.

JEL code on the left.

Through the line in the center - the title of the article.

On the right, under the name - the name and initials of the author full name of the organization.

The list of references is made out exclusively by footnotes (at the end of the corresponding page on which the link is made), issued in the APA style.

In the letter's subject, indicate " **The role of Euro-Atlantic Integration, High Technologies and Education in the Defence and Security of Ukraine.**" File name – surname-abstract.doc(x)
